Understanding the ethics process.

BEFORE APPLYING TO UROS

1

Prior to submitting an application for a UROS bursary, you need to initiate a draft application on the Lincoln Ethics Application System (LEAS). When creating your LEAS application, prefix the title of the application with LEAS, and the year. Ensure this is the same on your application form.

EXAMPLE: UROS-23_Investigating the Impact of Student Peer Mentoring



AT THIS STAGE - DO NOT SUBMIT THE LEAS APPLICATION, SAVE THE DRAFT UNTIL YOUR UROS BURSARY IS AWARDED.

Worth noting:

When initiating your ethics application the LEAS system will generate a reference number, this is the ethics application reference needed for your application.

If the project is to be part of a larger project which already has ethics approval, please use the approved project ethics reference.

If your bursary is approved, you'll be informed by LALT it has been granted. Only at this stage, should you send off the draft LEAS application created at the beginning.
